- Secretariat to survey past Justice Summit participants to seek input on possible themes and priorities for Justice Summits in 2019.
- It was recommended that the Secretariat seek input from the Judiciary on the Justice Summits through a separate process.

The JPSC reviewed a draft document outlining the role of the Justice and Public Safety Council as set out in the *Justice Reform and Transparency Act* (2013) and possible options to improve the process.

The JPSC discussed the approach for tracking and reporting on Justice Summit recommendations.
