Jay Chalke provided an overview of the National Action Committee on Access to Justice (NAACAJ) and its October 2013 report, *Access to Civil & Family Justice: A Roadmap for Change*. On November 19, the Honourable Mr. Justice Thomas Cromwell (chair of the NAACAJ) met in Vancouver with key stakeholders to discuss the recommendations of the report.
