Justice Summit cycle 2018

Richard, Mark, Allan and Tami provided members with an update on planning for the Tenth Justice Summit (Indigenous Justice):

- The Summit is being co-organized with the BC Aboriginal Justice Council, who are leading the identification of Indigenous participation and speakers.
- The Summit will be held at the Musqueam Community Centre. A number of steps are being taken by the Steering Committee and Working Circle in working with Indigenous organizations and the Musqueam Band to ensure that the event is culturally appropriate, both with respect to the hosts and with respect to Indigenous attendees.

Members made further suggestions regarding inclusion of justice and public safety organizations at the Summit.

 Kurt and Allan provided an overview of the sequence of related events in 2018, including the proposed all-Indigenous Justice Forum tentatively discussed as occurring in September, and the following Eleventh Justice Summit in November, and linkage to the Indigenous Justice Strategy flowing from the September 2017 MOU between the justice ministries and the BC Aboriginal Justice Council.
